SMALL GROUP AND SOLOIST INFORMATION

Small Group Numbers (Duets, Trios, and Quartets) with Private Coach

Small Group skaters are responsible for scheduling lessons with a private coach for choreography and will pay for their own ice, coaching fees, and costumes. ***Music selection and costume choices must be preapproved by the show director by July 20th.***

No audition is required for participation and skaters may perform in one or both days of the show. Please be sure to confirm with the private instructor if you will be participating in one or both performances. Please indicate the show performance(s) you will attend on your registration form.

Soloists with Private Coach

All solo numbers are by invite only. Nominations may be submitted by the skater's head coach to the show director by July 7th. Priority will be given to skaters with a consistent axel and above and will focus on building a well-rounded, diverse, and entertaining show.

All small group and solo numbers must reflect the show's theme, both in music choice and costume design.

MANDATORY DRESS REHEARSAL INFORMATION

The mandatory dress rehearsal (for ALL PERFORMERS including Large Groups, Small Groups and Soloists) is scheduled for Saturday, August 10th, 2024 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Please plan to arrive an hour early (by 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 10th) to prepare for this dress rehearsal.

SHOW REGISTRATION FEES

\$250 – per Group Performer through our Learn to Skate Program: (Snowplow 2 - Basic 2, Adult 2 and Up, and TOI) fee includes: costume, all on-ice rehearsals and instruction, off-ice rehearsals (if called by the coach), dress rehearsal, and one or both performances. *(Cost reflects 7 week rehearsal dates)*

\$225 – per Group Performer through our Learn to Skate Program: (Basic 3 through Pre-Free Skate, Free Skate 1 and Up, and Inflatables) fee includes: costume, all on-ice rehearsals and instruction, off-ice rehearsals (if called by the coach), dress rehearsal, and one or both performances. *(Cost reflects 6 week rehearsal dates)*

\$75 – per Ensemble Performer in a Small Group Number once music and costume have been approved by show director

\$75 – per Soloist once nominated by coach and selected by show director.

If you do not have a private instructor and would like to participate in a small group number, please contact the Show Committee at shows@iceandfield.com for assistance.

Complimentary Closing Number: All show skaters will be announced in the closing number and will wear the costume from their performance number.

Parents will receive a maximum of one free General Admission ticket (seating in the stands) per performance.

- Show participation fees are non-refundable. A credit may be considered with a doctor's note in the event of serious injury or illness.
- Multi-class discounts and makeup lessons are not applicable to show fees.
- Skaters will receive \$5 LTS admission rates for public sessions for all Learn to Skate group participants (this does not include the private lesson group participants UNLESS they are also enrolled in a current Learn to Skate class).
- Each show participant will receive a complimentary show t-shirt with options to purchase additional swag as well.

COSTUMES

- LTS group costumes will be secured by the Show Committee.
- Ensemble Costumes must be secured no later than Saturday, July 20th to ensure they arrive in time for the show. This will be handled by the private instructor after approval from the show director.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **For insurance purposes, all show performers must be current members of Learn to Skate USA or U. S. Figure Skating.**
- Please contact the Show Committee at shows@iceandfield.com if you have questions about memberships. (Note, Learn to Skate USA membership is included with all Ice & Field Learn to Skate class registrations. All skaters who have registered for a Learn to Skate session at Ice & Field at the Crossover since July 1, 2024, should have a current Learn to Skate USA membership. All show registrations will be reviewed for current memberships.)
- All choreography and show production will be directed by Ice & Field staff. Show fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. A credit may be issued with a doctor's note. **A maximum of (1) absence will be allowed without pre-approval by show coach and director. If you are absent from a show practice, please contact the coach for opportunities to catch up on missed choreography/rehearsals. If absence is approved, skaters may be asked to attend an additional practice or private lessons to learn choreography.**
- Please plan to arrive one hour prior to each show time. Skaters may choose to perform in just one show if unable to attend both dates with written permission from the primary coach and show director.
- **Dress rehearsal attendance on Saturday, August 10th from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. is MANDATORY.**
